ROLE

- Respond to escalated questions and issues from internal stakeholders and program members
- In collaboration with internal and external stakeholders; develop, implement and oversee the delivery of
 products and the program to support the Excellence program. Monitor, evaluate and adjust as required
- Assist with the development and execution of marketing plans and tactics to increase program awareness and participation
- Create resources, tools and presentation material for member meetings to assist firms with successfully meeting the program requirements
- Monitor and evaluate to ensure the program content is effectively and consistently being delivered

2. Relationship building (30%)

 Collaborate with the assigned WSIB consultant, Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training Skills and Development (MLITSD), and other system partners, Manager OHS Management Systems, WSPS Consulting Managers and Consultants, support staff and Excellence program members to ensure the delivery of a high quality program

3. Marketing Initiatives (10%)

Recommend marketing collateral and Excellence program member recruitment strategies
